- A twelve-acre property surrounded by farm fields and a memorial forest
- Peaceful walking trails, butterfly gardens, tranquil patio
- Beautiful outdoor common area with a propane BBQ
- Warm home-like atmosphere
- Four private rooms (soon to be six with ensuite bathrooms)
- Hospital bed with linens (families can bring preferred linens and pillows)
- Some rooms have pullout couches for a family to use overnight as needed
- Small fridge in each room for cold drinks and light snacks (families can bring their own favourite snacks, drinks and comfort foods)
- Pets on a leash are welcome

# Huron Hospice Bender House offers

- Physician on call 24 hours a day
- Two specialized nurses providing personal care and expert pain and symptom management
- Spa room with walk-in shower and tub with a lift (a shower chair is available)
- Weekday pharmacy delivery
- Cooking and laundry on-site provided by staff and volunteers

### 24/7 Nursing Care

Keeping person–family care at the forefront by addressing issues, goals, hopes, needs and fears that are all part of the dying process.









# What to Expect When Your Loved One Arrives At Bender House

- Once a bed is confirmed, transport by patient transfer on a stretcher will need to be arranged. Bender House staff will assist with this.
- Please bring your health card and Power of Attorney paperwork with you.
- Nursing staff will complete other documents and paperwork upon arrival and on an ongoing basis.
- You are welcome to bring comfort items from home
- There are no set visiting hours.
